

# Taking Public Transit to the Boston Office

## ON THE T:

Take the Red Line to the Harvard Square T stop. Exit the stop and continue east down Massachusetts Avenue until you get to 1280 Massachusetts Avenue.

If you are coming from the airport, pick up the Silver Line bus outside any terminal and take it to South Station. Transfer to a Red Line train towards Alewife. Exit at Harvard Square.

## ON THE BUS:

If you are staying in Boston, the Massachusetts Ave #1 will take you into Harvard Square. Massachusetts Avenue is accessible by foot from most major Boston hotels, but it is also accessible by T; the #1 picks up just outside the Hynes Convention Center-ICA stop on the Green Line, where Massachusetts Avenue intersects Newbury Street.

Depending on your location, there are several different bus lines that terminate in Harvard Square.

## ON THE BOAT:

If you are traveling from Quincy or the South Shore, you can take a ferry to either Long Wharf or Rowes Wharf ([http://www.mbta.com/schedules\\_and\\_maps/boats/](http://www.mbta.com/schedules_and_maps/boats/)).

From Long Wharf, get on the Blue Line inbound at the Aquarium stop. Transfer at Government Center to a Green Line inbound train (B, C, D, or E). Take the train one stop to Park Street, and transfer to the Red Line towards Alewife.

From Rowes Wharf, get on the Silver Line at the World Trade Center, and take it to South Station. Transfer to a Red Line towards Alewife. Exit at Harvard Square.
